DIRECTIONS TO ÀMAURICE FROM:

**SEATTLE, WASHINGTON**

(273 miles, approximate travel time is 4 to 4.5 hours)

We are located in the scenic Mill Creek area of the Walla Walla Valley in the very southeast corner of Washington State. Our airport is served by Horizon Air, a partner of Northwest and Alaska Airlines.

- Take “I-90” east toward Spokane.
- Take Exit #110 “I 82 East” following signs to Yakima.
- Take Exit #102 “182/12 East” toward Richland/Pasco.
- Travel through the Tri-Cities following signs for Walla Walla.
- Just past Boise Cascade (on your right) cross one more bridge and bend left to a stop. Turn left onto “Highway 12” and travel 30 miles east to Walla Walla.
- When you reach Walla Walla, travel to east side of the city and take the “Port of Walla Walla/Airport exit.” It is the first exit past Wilbur Avenue.
- At the end of the off ramp, turn right onto “Airport Road.”
- At the first signal turn left onto “Isaacs.” From this intersection you will travel 3.8 miles to our driveway.
- Isaacs will become Mill Creek Road.
- At 2.4 miles you will come to a “Y.” Five Mile Road travels right. Stay left continuing on Mill Creek Road.
- Vineyard lane will be on the left about one and four tenths miles past the “Y.” It is shared with Walla Walla Vintners, and there is signage for both wineries.
- Our driveway is the first on the right, and the entrance to the building is on the back (east) side.
